Once again I am blown away by the desire of you and the people of Franklin Naz. to truly Be the Church! I thank God for the way you have turned this desire into action by signing up to serve at the Kids Against Hunger Factory on Saturday, July 17.

What can we do to prepare for our service on July 17?

First and foremost, let us prepare with prayer. Pray boldly and specifically for the Holy Spirit to empower us in our service, to make this an event in which our unchurched friends and family experience the presence of Christ and for the Father to get the spotlight!

What should I expect?

First, a brief training session. Next, we will be divided into assembly lines of 10 people each and another twenty able-bodied people will serve as box carriers. Then, the music will blast and we will have a blast packaging meals! The faster we are, the more children we save! I can tell you this.... my assembly line will be the line to beat! :-)

How do I get there?

A map and directions are included in this packet. With no traffic or construction it takes a full 37 minutes from Franklin Naz. Please add 15 minutes to however long it will take you to get there from your home so we can all arrive, not only on time, but early.

What if I am late?

If you are a person who has the gift of tardiness, plan now NOT to use that gift on July 17. You can be better than on time; you can be early. We need you to be early. I believe in you! You can do it!

What about children?

If your child is 8 years or older, they should be fine serving for the entire time. If you have younger children, please make the call depending on your child. For instance, we are bringing our older two children, but leaving our 3 year with a sitter because we know that after five minutes he would be attempting to drive the fork lift. KAH has said at times they let young children color on the boxes, which the recipients enjoy.
